## DOGS ONTO THE CONEY WESTON PLAYING FIELD

## NB – These views and suggestions are in no particular order and represent the views and suggestions of both the Parish Council and residents alike

- 1. Some children are genuinely afraid of dogs and allowing them onto the playing field area would scare them and therefore they are less likely to use the facility.
- 2. The Parish Council do not have the authority to make this decision it is up to the Trustees of the Playing Field Committee to make the decision and enact it.
- 3. Dogs should be allowed only on the recreation area, not in the fenced off area of the playing arena.
- 4. Dogs are an important part of family life a lot of children benefit from having and interacting with dogs.
- 5. Some leads are extendable which would allow the dog a much longer rein to use the area.
- 6. Dog fouling has already been seen on the playing field area.
- 7. The purchase of a dog mess bin would cost approximately £150 a cost which would be bourn by the Playing Field Committee.
- 8. A contract to empty the bin could cost approximately £170 p.a. which would also be the responsibility of the Playing Field Committee.
- 9. Parish Councillors voted 2 against and 3 in favour (on leads) for allowing dogs on the Playing Field area.
- 10. Suggestion to have a 6 month trial if the Trustees decide to allow dogs on the area.
